Instrumental Music Program

Montmorency Secondary College has a proud history of providing quality music education. The aim of the MSC Instrumental Music Program is to develop a students' musical, social and personal awareness through participation in music instruction, ensembles, rehearsals, and performances.

Our program provides a rich developmental musical experience for all students in Years 7 to 12. The program is available to students who have never played a musical instrument, through to the accomplished musician. It provides a wide selection of specialist music tuition in woodwind, brass, strings, percussion, and bass guitar. Students also have the choice to study piano, guitar (acoustic or electric) and voice with independent private music teachers.

Students who are learning an instrument are encouraged to participate in the various MSC ensembles to experience the joy of music making and to stimulate their interest in music.

Lessons

The lessons are held on a rotating basis throughout the school day. The lessons are provided in either small groups, or as individual lessons, depending on the student's level of skill and student groupings. Timetabling the lessons on a rotating basis minimises the disruption to the student's school day.
